If <b>systolic</b> blood pressure (the first number) is <b>greater than 130</b> or the <b>diastolic</b>
blood pressure (the second number) is <b>greater than 90</b> , this is considered elevated
blood pressure or <b>hyper</b> tension. Both numbers do not need to be elevated in order
to be classified as hypertension. One elevated number is sufficient to establish the
diagnosis. Low blood pressure ( <b>hypo</b> tension) is when the <b>systolic</b> (first number) is
less than 90 or diastolic (second number) is less than 50. Return to our office
earlier than your scheduled appointments if you are consistently running above
or lower than the values stated
